National Academic Depository (NAD) (www.nad.co.in) is a national database set up by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) to hold academic awards issued by Academic Institutions (AI) in electronic form. CDSL had introduced NAD in 2010 with a view to obviate the issues associated with the issue of academic mark sheets, degrees and convocation certificates in paper form. CDSL had recently signed-up with UoM for providing the services of NAD to UoM.
