RELEASE OF NEW FUNCTIONALITY IN DPC9 REPORT

CDSL have received request from DPs to provide online facility to setup DPC9 report for multiple BOs. CDSL is now pleased to inform regarding release of new functionality whereby CDAS system will allow DPs to upload bulk BO file for generation of DPC9 reports (**refer Annexure A – DPC9 Upload File format**).

The new facility will be available in the exiting DPC9 setup menu. Report will be available to download in formatted and unformatted type.

Points to remember

1. DPC9 report can be setup for a maximum of 9999 records (BOIDs).
2. If the user sets up more than the specified records than the file will get generated only for first 9999 records and the rest of the records will be ignored.

DPs are advised to take note of the same.

Note:-

- 1) DPID mentioned in the file name should be of logged in DP.
- 2) Only valid BOID present in the upload file will be considered for generation of DPC9 report.
- 3) If more than 9999 BOID are mentioned in a file then system will generate DPC9 for 9999 records only and further records will be ignored.
- 4) DPC9 Report file will be generated with naming convention as 08DPC9U.Event-id.gz

- 5) No response report will be generated for success/failure records.
