### UPDATION OF MERGER BANKS DETAILS

DPs are aware that pursuant to the Public Sector Mergers, MICR & IFSCs of Bank accounts held with the below mentioned Amalgamating Bank have undergone changes along with the change in the name of the Bank to Merged Bank (Account number remains the same), detail of the PSU Bank is as mentioned below.

Further in case of the following Banks along with the changes in MICR & IFSCs, Bank name the beneficiary account numbers also have been replaced with the details of the Amalgamating Bank.

Based on the data received from Merged Bank, the existing MICR - IFSCs combination of Amalgamating Bank has been replaced with the new MICR - IFSC combination of Merged Bank (where new MICR - IFSC of Merged Bank exists in CDSL Bank Master, i.e. CD10). The bank name of the merged bank is also updated for all demat accounts with bank account details.

DPs are advised to note that the list of BO IDs wherein the IFSCs & MICR have been updated, has been placed in the DP's billing folder on July 01, 2021 with the file name as <BLNG><DP\_ID>\_ALLAHABADPSU\_MERGER, <BLNG><DP\_ID>\_ANDHRAPSU\_MERGER and <BLNG><DP\_ID>\_VIJDENAPSU\_MERGER. The details provided in the file are as follows **BOID~OldMICR~NewMICR~OldIFSC~NewIFSC**.

DPs are advised to note that in case of BOs wherein the change is not affected due to incorrect Bank details, DPs are required to update the same on the basis of modification form.

The above updations were carried out on June 30, 2021 and changes are reflected in DPD1, DPS8, DPS9 and DPB9 reports which was generated during EOD of June 30, 2021. It may be noted that CDSL will send the email and SMS alerts of the update to these BOs who have registered email id and mobile no. in the demat account and opted for SMS Alerts.
