OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR CAPTURING DARPAN REGISTRATION ID IN DEMAT ACCOUNTS OF NON-PROFIT ORGANISATION

DPs are advised to refer to CDSL communique CDSL/OPS/DP/P OLCY/2024/337 dated June 19, 2024 regarding the issuance of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSDSECFATF/P/CIR/2024/78 dated June 06, 2024 and regarding Guidelines on Anti-Money Laundering (AML) Standards and Combating the Financing of Terrorism (CFT) /Obligations of Securities Market Intermediaries under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 and Rules framed there under.

In the view of above mentioned SEBI Circular, every registered intermediary shall register the details of Darpan ID on the portal of NITI Aayog, in case the client is a non-profit organization. Further DPs are advised to maintain such registration records for a period of five years after the client closes the demat account.

Capturing of the DARPAN Registration ID will be mandatory for demat accounts opened under the following Status–Sub Status categories applicable to Non-Profit Organisations (NPOs). For the existing demat account under these sub-status categories, Darpan ID field will be mandatory at the time of account modification.

File format changes related to capturing Darpan ID have been published in UDIFF catalogue v3.0.1.2 and the same can be downloaded from <https://www.cdslindia.com/DP/Harmonization.html>. DPs are advised to note the above changes and carry out the necessary back-office changes wherever applicable. The said functionality is scheduled for release on live tentatively on Friday, 07 August, 2026.



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DPs are advised to take note of the same and ensure compliance.
